A. Policies for Admission to the Major <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. New students (freshmen and transfers) must be admitted to the Finance major by the Office of Admissions upon admission to the University.2. Admission into the Finance major from other departments (including undeclared students) is upon approval of the chairperson of the Finance Department3. Non-degree and continuing education students must be admitted to the Finance major by the Office of Admissions.	
B. Policies for Retention in the Major <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. University requirements for retention.	
C. Policies for Completion of the Major <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Completion of all University curricular requirements.2. Students wishing to major in Finance must complete each of the following courses with a grade of C- (C minus) or higher, and maintain a GPA of 2.0 or higher in the Foundations Block prior to enrolling in any other courses within Business Administration: ECON 101, 102, BUAD 161, 162, 202. Note that BUAD 161 requires a prerequisite of MATH 101 or MATH placement beyond MATH 101.3. Students majoring in Finance are required to attain a C- or higher in BUAD 161, 162, 202, 251, and 341 before taking courses which have these courses as prerequisites.4. ENGL 316, Business Writing, is required as the upper-level writing course under the General Education Curriculum.
