## **Student Involvement**

- Climate Summit Conference Collaboration with RegenAll (Ware Center, April 2024)
  - Six faculty and three students presented.
  - Five student group project posters.
  - 140 Attendees.
- Students advocated for reinstating residence hall recycling August 2024.
- On-Campus Sustainability Engagement Events
  - **Ubuntu Day**, attended by 68 students, who learned more about the 17 United Nations Sustainable Goals and their connection to Ubuntu philosophy of "I am because you are".
  - National Recycling Day event and Earth Day event.
- 12 Honors College students and Millersville University faculty participated in a shortterm study abroad program, focused on international organizations and sustainability, to the Netherlands, Belgium, France, and Switzerland. (May 2024)

#### University Dining Waste Reduction

- The Dish Room in the Upper Deck was reopened in Fall 2023 Reduced the institutional carbon footprint and provided a projected savings of \$125,000-\$150,000 annually.
- Plastic-bottled Pepsi products were removed from the meal equivalency options across all dining locations in Fall 2023.
- Brandywine Project Workshop June 2024
  - Faculty attended this workshop that facilitates greater understanding of sustainability.
