

Millersville University: Indian Standard XII Credit Awarding Procedure

Millersville University recognizes the value of the rigorous [Central Board of Secondary Education \(CBSE\)](#) & [Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations \(CISCE\) curriculum](#) and considers it seriously when evaluating the credentials of admission applicants. Credit will be awarded on a course-by-course basis for exams taken at the CBSE & CISCE curriculum and graded a US equivalent "A" (e.g., A-2 or 81%) or above unless indicated otherwise in the equivalency chart. Credit awarded for CBSE & CISCE Standard XII Examinations may be used to satisfy general education requirements, major or minor requirements, or electives in the same manner as Advanced Placement (AP). Students will not receive duplicate credit for IB examinations, AP examinations, A & AS Levels, or any other college courses taken before or after enrolling at Millersville University.
