MU's Special Education Post-Master's in School Supervision is designed for instructional level II teachers or specialists with 5 years of appropriate experience to develop supervisory skills in special education.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The supervisor certificate provides experienced educators an opportunity to advance their careers in knowledge and skills needed to be teacher-leaders.
